From September 2021 statutory induction is changing. Schools must offer their new early career teachers (ECTs) a 2 year induction programme.

The Department for Education (DfE) has provided:

- statutory guidance so that schools know their roles and responsibilities
- guidance on the 3 approaches that are compliant with the new regulations:
- 1. an approved training provider leads the programme
- the school delivers the programme using DfE accredited materials
- schools design and deliver their own programme based on the early career framework (ECF)




