

FIRST AID COURSES - AUTUMN 2021

FREE BOLT-ON - Anaphylaxis Module - Course cost normally £55

This will apply to anyone attending any of the accredited courses. The module will be offered at the end of each accredited course and is expected to last approximately 1 hour.

FIRST AID AT WORK (3 days)

The IQL Level 3 First Aid at Work Qualification covers a wide range of CPR and first aid skills, equipping the first-aider with the ability to apply first aid to a range of specific injuries and illness and providing them with the skills to ensure a safe working environment. The qualification is Ofqual accredited and valid for three years.

The course comprises of practical work and theoretical classroom work, as well as a practical assessment on CPR and first aid. First Aid at Work is trainer assessed throughout the course and the assessment should determine a candidate's ability to act safely, promptly and effectively when an emergency occurs at work and to deal with a casualty.

FIRST AID AT WORK REFRESHER (2 days)

The refresher course is only two days, provided that candidates have a valid First Aid at Work qualification at the time of renewal. A copy of the certificate must be forwarded with the application form for presentation to the awarding body.

PAEDIATRIC FIRST AID (2 days)

The IQL Level 3 Paediatric First Aid covers a wide range of CPR and first aid skills related to children, providing the participant with the skills to ensure a safe environment for children and infants. The qualification is Ofqual accredited and valid for three years.

The course comprises of practical work and theoretical classroom work, as well as a practical assessment on CPR and first aid. Paediatric First Aid is trainer assessed throughout the course and the assessment should determine a candidate's ability to act safely, promptly and effectively when an emergency occurs at work and to deal with a casualty.

- Basic life support skills (Adult) - not breathing
- Moving and handling of a breathing but unconscious casualty
- Diagnosis and treatment of choking
- Diagnosis and treatment of drowning
- Understanding and practical application of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED)

- Understanding and practical application of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED)
