

SAFEGUARDING COURSES - AUTUMN TERM 2021

PEER-ON-PEER ABUSE - Spotlight Session

This dynamic, high quality session will provide professionals with an up-to-date CPD experience. Areas of focus, from Keeping children safe in education' (September 2021):

- Awareness of peer-on-peer abuse, and the lived experiences for pupils today both online and offline
- Understanding the prevalence of what constitutes harmful sexual behaviour
- Examining the definitions of sexual harassment and sexual violence, including online sexual abuse
- Recognise the early indicators of peer-on-peer abuse
- Creating a culture of openness (in relation to hearing disclosures) and supporting children to bring issues to trusted adults
- Responding effectively to concerns when identified or reported

ONLINE SAFETY - Spotlight Session

This dynamic, high quality CPD session will provide professionals with an up-to-date insight into the digital world pupils are living in today. It will focus on the relevant challenges the internet poses towards our pupils i.e. sharing, chatting, playing and 'friendships'. Areas of focus, from Keeping children safe in education' (September 2021):

- Awareness of social media, chat platforms, live streaming and gaming
- Examining content: being exposed to illegal, inappropriate or harmful material including online challenges
- Recognising harmful contact: including grooming and exploitation
- Exploring the impact of conduct: including the consensual and non-consensual sharing of nudes and semi-nude images as well as cyber-bullying
- Identifying commerce: including the risk from online gambling
- Empowering digital resiliency with pupils
- Responding effectively to concerns

MENTAL HEALTH - Spotlight Session

This dynamic, high quality session will provide professionals with an up-to-date CPD experience. Areas of focus, from Keeping children safe in education' (September 2021):

- Exploration of what is 'mental health'
- Awareness of the impact of traumatic and adverse experiences on pupil's mental health and behaviour
- Examine the ways in which mental health problems may present
- Recognise the indicators which suggest a pupil may be experiencing a mental health problem
- Responding effectively to concerns
- Developing resiliency in pupils
- Exploring self-care

LEVEL 1 SAFEGUARDING/CHILD PROTECTION AWARENESS - Live Virtual

Statutory training meeting the requirement of the 'robust 3-yearly training' for whole staff communities. This course is essential for all staff working within an education setting. Exploring Duty of Care in line with Local Safeguarding Children Partnership (formally LSCB) procedures, and the latest government guidance 'Keeping Children Safe in Education (September 2021)'.

Course content includes:

- Understanding of national guidance and procedures
- Recognising the four categories of abuse
- Empowering the voice of a child
- Awareness raising of key challenges including Mental Health, Adverse childhood experiences – including Domestic Abuse, Online Safety, Radicalisation, Criminal Exploitation (including County Lines and Child Sexual Exploitation) and HBA (Honour-Based Abuse including FGM – Female Genital Mutilation)

This virtual training is delivered in one session with a short comfort break. All delegates will receive a PDF accredited certificate and a handout from the session.

DESIGNATED SAFEGUARDING LEAD/ADVANCED CHILD PROTECTION - Live Virtual

Statutory requirement for education professionals meeting 'robust 2-yearly training' for those with a lead or designated professional role for safeguarding in schools. Having completed basic safeguarding training, this course equips professionals to perform their senior safeguarding function in schools.

Course content includes:

- Latest legislation and procedures – reflecting the Education Acts and Keeping Children Safe in Education (September 2021)
- Policy development
- Awareness of multi-agency working
- Information sharing
- The referral processes
- Thresholds or risk analysis within the context of children and young people
- Management of safeguarding with staff and within schools – including the response to sexual violence and sexual harassment
- Challenging topics are also explored from a management level
