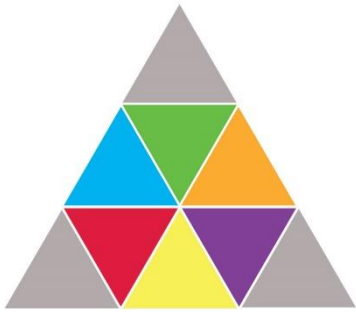


Middle Leader's Programme
