### **French Pronunciation for Primary Teachers - Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> May**

To become more confident about teaching the grammar normally encountered in French language learning in Years 3 & 4, we will examine and practise the following through interactive and engaging activities:

- Gender of nouns
- Singular and plural nouns
- Indefinite article
- Position of adjectives
- Some high frequency verbs
- Negative sentences
- 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> person pronouns

### **French Grammar for Primary Teachers in Years 5 & 6 - Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> June**

This course is for anyone who lacks confidence in their knowledge of French grammar. It is suitable for complete beginners as well as those with 'rusty' language skills.

It is designed to help you become more confident about teaching the grammar normally encountered in French language learning in Years 5 & 6. For beginners, it would be beneficial to attend first the grammar course for teaching in Years 3 & 4. We will examine and practise the following through interactive and engaging activities:

- Gender of nouns
- 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> person pronouns in the singular and plural
- 2<sup>nd</sup> person familiar and formal pronoun
- Adjectival agreement in the singular and plural
- Definite article
- High frequency and -er verbs in complex positive and negative sentence building
